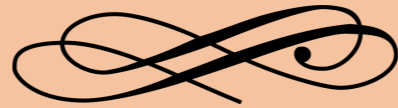


Charles Brown Grave

Died 6 April 1882



Originally from Glasgow, Scotland, Charles Brown died suddenly aged around 60 years old.



An alluvial gold miner, Charles had been destitute and reliant on the generosity of friends to survive. It was decided by his friends that he would be buried in the bush near his hut.

A burial in the Aberfeldy Cemetery just six kilometres away would have cost 12 pounds. It was more money than they could spare. As it was, the few belongings he had owned, including 16 grams of gold, were sold to cover the funeral costs for his bush burial.
