It's service area included Landy's Dream, the Shamrock, the Scratabit group of mines and the McGregor mine on the Aberfeldy River.

It is not known if a telephone or telegraph facilities were ever available at Holmedale.

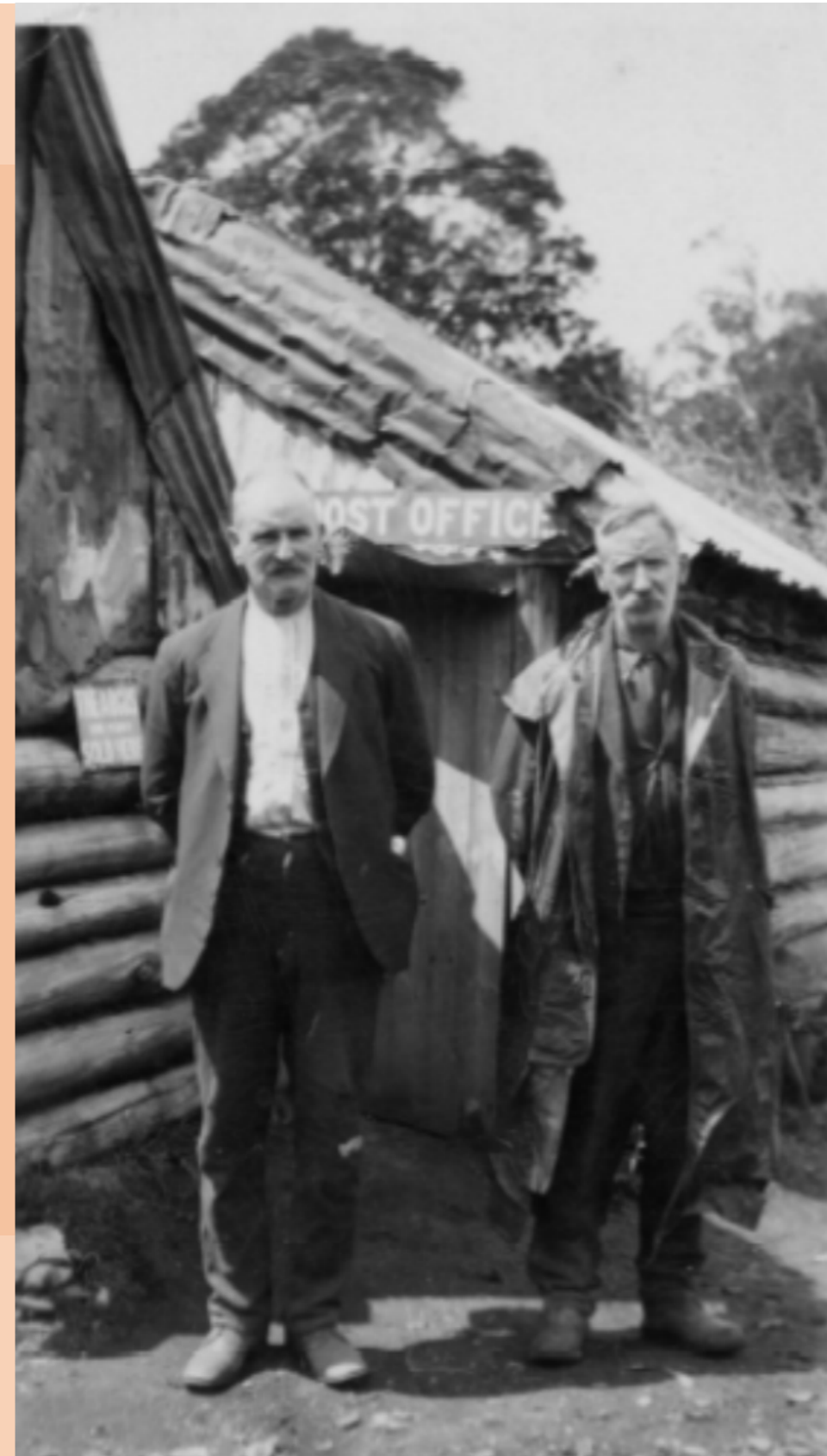


Photo: A typical image of a shack like establishment which ran as a 1860's post office.
