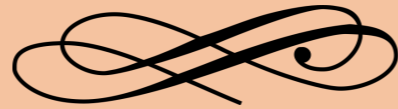


TAYLOR FAMILY GRAVE

c.1860's



This site is recorded as the last resting place of Mrs Taylor and one or two of her children who died while the family were resident at Point View.



A large tree once stood near the grave and Mrs Taylor's name was carved into the trunk. The tree was at some stage destroyed by fire and now the Christian names of Mrs Taylor and her children are unknown. None of the deaths were officially registered, and the causes of death not ascertained.
